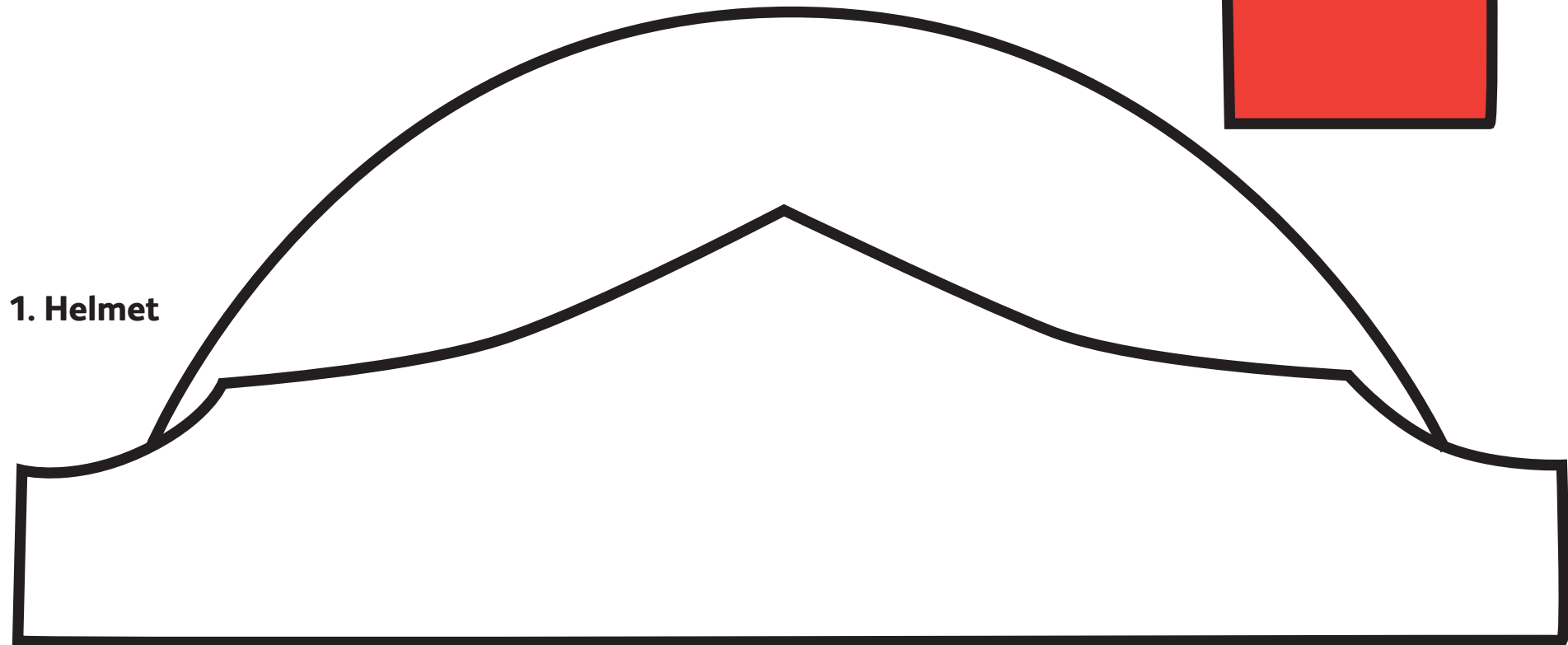
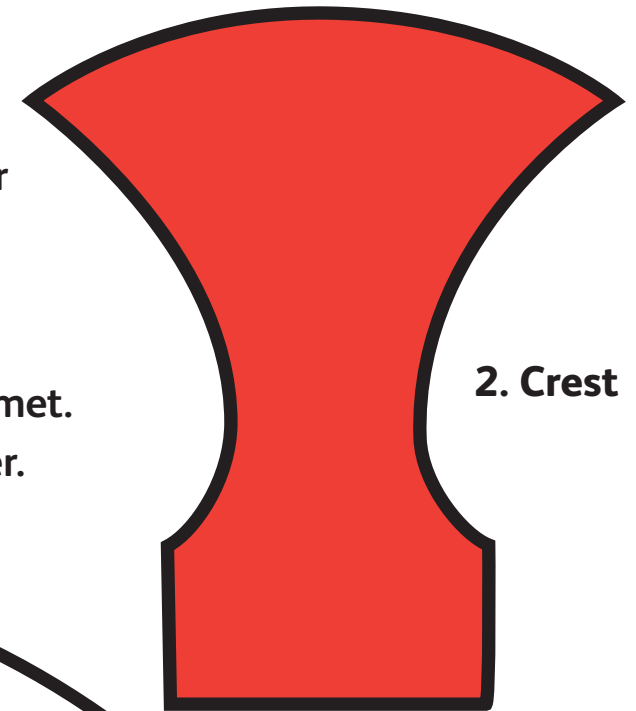


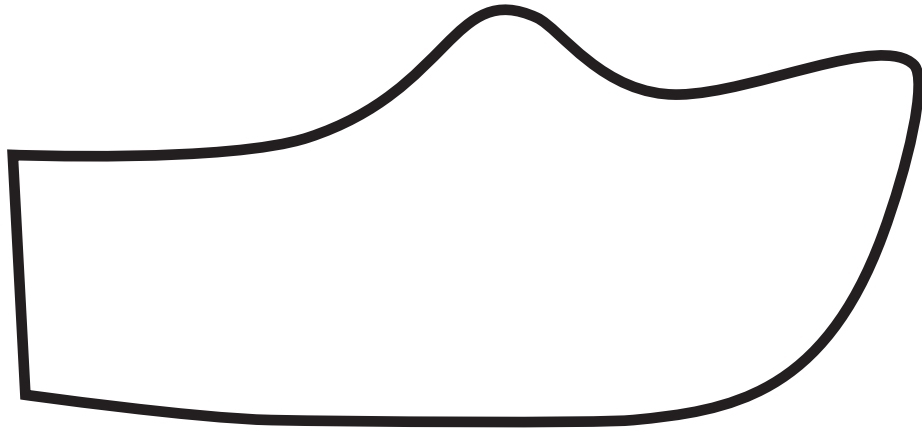
Make a Roman Centurion Helmet

Romans soldiers, such as those who defended Hadrian's wall, wore armour for protection. Have a go at making your own Roman Centurion helmet.

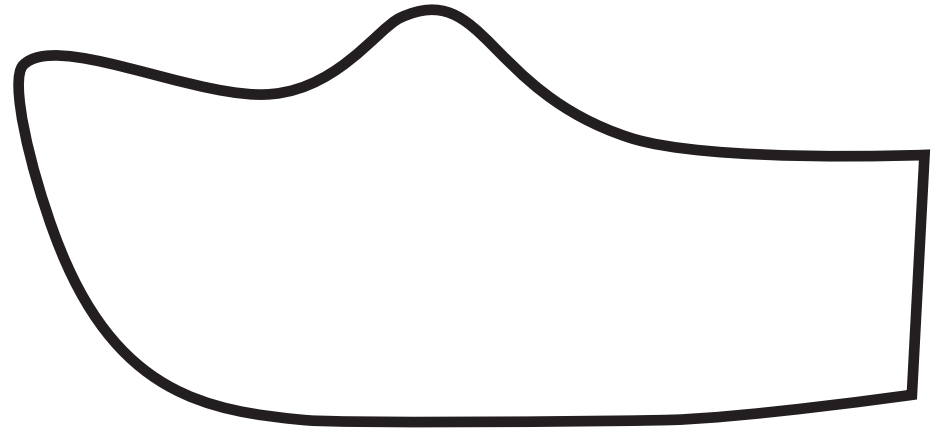
- Cut out all the pieces.
- Using glue, or cellotape, stick the crest (2) on the top of the helmet (1).
- Next stick the left (3) and right (4) cheek pieces to the bottom of your helmet.
- Finally, attach a red band to each side of the helmet and fasten together.
- You can now wear your Centurion helmet!
