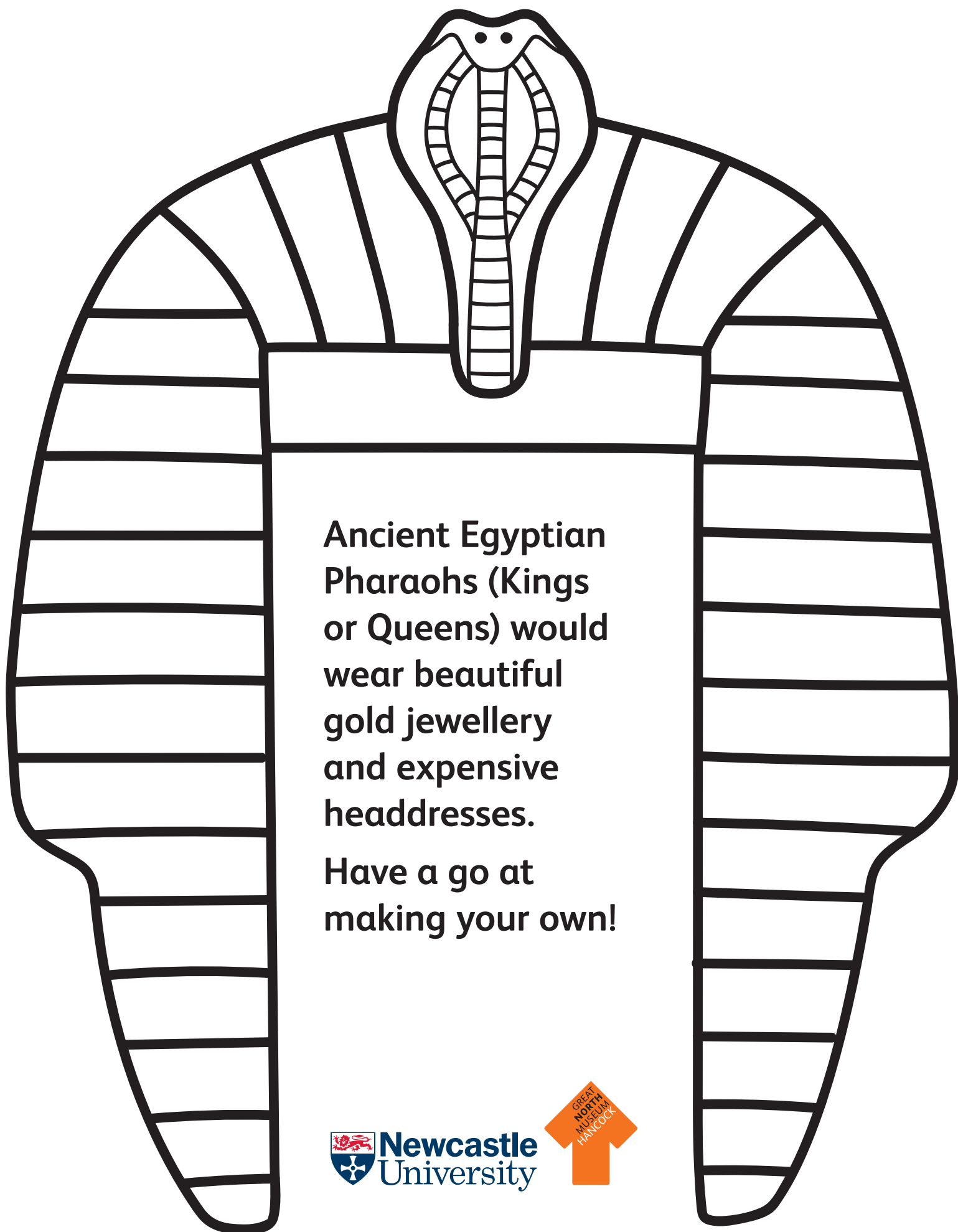


Make an Ancient Egyptian Headdress



Ancient Egyptian Pharaohs (Kings or Queens) would wear beautiful gold jewellery and expensive headdresses.

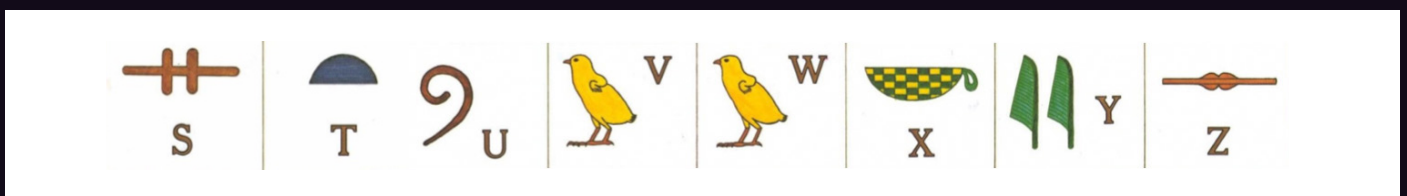
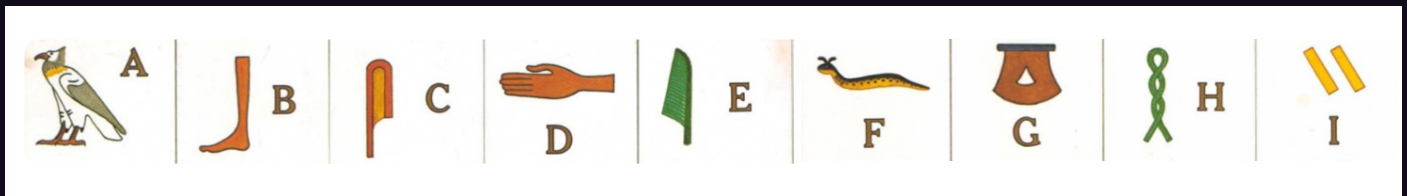
Have a go at making your own!

Make an Ancient Egyptian Headdress

1. Cut out the three long bands and Egyptian headdress
2. Colour in your headdress
3. Using glue, or cellotape, fasten the bands together and add the headdress. The bands will hold the headdress in place, so that you can wear it on your head!

Did you know that the Ancient Egyptians wrote in a different language called Hieroglyphics?

These are the symbols, little pictures, shown on the three bands.



Once you've made your headdress maybe you could have a go at writing your name in Hieroglyphics.
