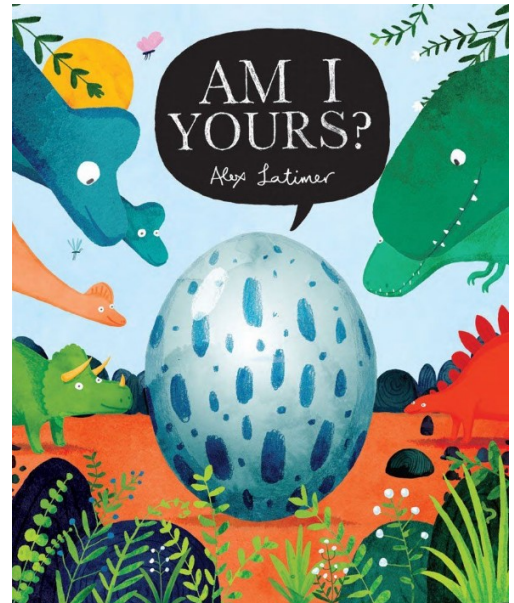


# Am I Yours?

**Where can I use this story kit? We suggest using the Fossils and Dinosaurs Gallery**

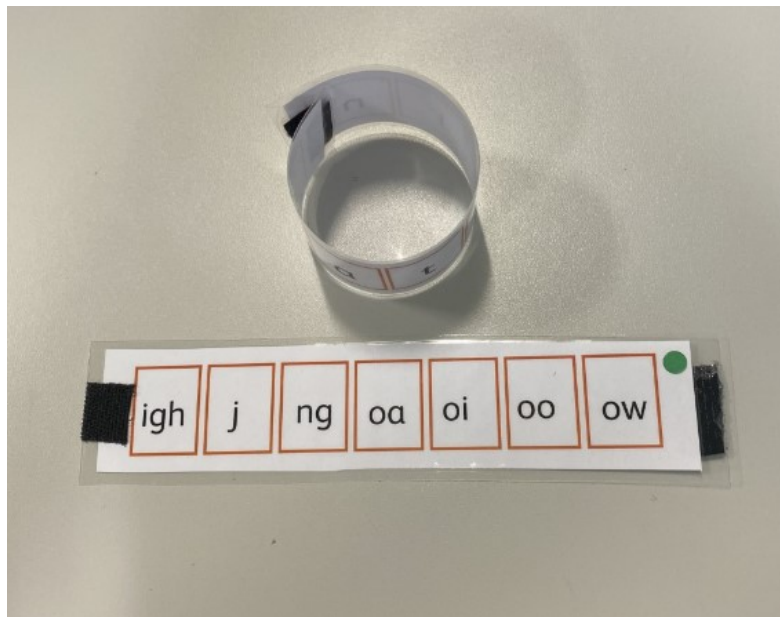
**Once you've finished, please ensure all items are placed back in the suitcase and is stored under the stairs in the butterfly corner or left with staff at the front desk.**

# Phonics Wristbands

**Where can I use the phonics wristbands?** These phonics wristbands can be used in any gallery.

**What phases are the phonics wristbands?** Wristbands are available from phases 2, 3 and 5.

**How do I use these wristbands?** Wear the wristband and turn it to the sound you'd like to practice or use.



## Activity Ideas

- **Spin the wristband to read all the sounds.** Pick a character from the story and read the sounds like the character. For example, read the sounds like a Tyrannosaurus.
- **Phonics detectives:** Pick a sound and find an object/animal/dinosaur/fossil that has the sound in the name.
- **Object detectives:** Find an object and check, does it include any of the sounds on your wheel?

## Shadow Puppets

### Game 1:

Play with the shapes of the shadows on the wall, can they make the shadows small and large? If the angle of the shadow change, look at the direction of the lights in the gallery.

### Game 2:

Use the puppets to retell the story or to make their own

## Rhyming Pairs

### Game 1: Pair Up!

Give the children a card each and ask them to find a partner who has a card that rhymes with their card.

### Game 2: Snap! (applicable for small groups)

Sit in a circle and place cards in the middle one at a time, children can then put their hands on the rhyming

## Scavenger Hunt Dice

Roll the dice to find out what type of object you need to look for in the gallery.

There are 2 dice in this pack so you can split your group into two groups and let the children take turns rolling the dice.
