Where can I use this story kit? We suggest reading the story in Natural Northumbria Gallery and completing activities in Natural Northumbria and Living Planet (First Floor).


Once you've finished, please ensure all items are placed back in the suitcase and is stored under the stairs in the butterfly corner or left with staff at the front desk.

Phonics wristbands

Where can I use the phonics wristbands? These phonics wristbands can be used in any gallery.

What phases are the phonics wristbands? Wristbands are available from phases 2, 3 and 5.


How do I use these wristbands? Wear the wristband and turn it to the sound you'd like to practice or use.



Activity Ideas

- Spin the wristband to read all the sounds. Pick a character from the story and read the sounds like the character. For example, read the sounds like a polar bear.
- Phonics detectives: Pick a sound and find an object/animal that has the sound in the name.
- **Object detectives:** Find an object and check, does it include any of the sounds on your wheel?
